Chief Scout's Gold Award



This form has been adapted from the Surrey County procedure form available on their website.

Gaining this award should be seen as a great achievement by a Scout and therefore all Scouts should have the opportunity to attend the County presentation. Please ensure that you are following the process below.

- ❖ The Scout needs to complete all of the elements of the up to date CSA Gold requirements.
- ❖ A member of the District Team should be informed that this has been achieved using the CSA notification form.
- ❖ Scout should be interviewed and have the badge presented by a suitable district representative at a suitable group occasion.
- ❖ Form should be signed by ADC/representative and sent to the County Scout Leader listed on the form. Only forms sent via the DC / ADC will be accepted. Scout leaders should not send any forms directly.
- ❖ When the form is received Scouts will be notified of the proposed date of the next presentation if an email address has been supplied.
- ❖ Six weeks before the presentation date the County Scout Leader will send ADCs a list of all the participants to ensure all relevant Scouts have been included.
- ❖ Four weeks before the event the County Scout Leader will invite the Scout, Leader and ADC to the next county Chief Scout Gold Presentation.
- ❖ At the presentation the Scout will be interviewed by the County Commissioner and the certificate will be presented by a guest of honour.
- ❖ The presentations take place at least twice a year. The Scout will be invited to two presentations – if they have not managed either then they will be given the option of having the certificate presented locally.
